PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENT

The Fulbright Teaching Excellence and Achievement (Fulbright TEA) Program, **General Pedagogy track**, brings international teachers to the United States for a six-week program that offers academic seminars for professional development at a host university. Participants observe classrooms and share their expertise with teachers and students at the host university and at local secondary schools. The international participants will travel to the United States for one of two six-week professional development programs in either spring of 2020 or fall of 2020. Upon returning home, teachers will be expected to share the knowledge and experience gained on the program with teachers and students in their home schools and within their communities.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Current secondary-level, full-time teachers of English, English as a Foreign Language (EFL), the language and literature of your home country, social studies, civics, history, global studies, law, math, science, and special education in the disciplines listed above.
- Bachelor's degree or equivalent
- Five or more years of full-time teaching experience at secondary school level
- Demonstrated oral and written English language proficiency
- Demonstrated evidence of leadership in their schools or communities
- Citizens and residents of Ukraine
- Other requirements as indicated in the application
